

# Snowman Christmas card



## Finished size

Approx 5" tall (snowman only)

## Materials

Worsted-weight yarn scraps (you really need just very little yarn!)

C (3.0 mm) crochet hook

Craft glue

3D-foampads

Scissors

Cardstock paper

Thicker white paper

Small piece of red paper

Pencil

Black fineliner

Small piece of cardboard (0,6")

Very tiny buttons or small scraps of colored paper

Comb (optional)

## Pattern

### Winter hat

*Using a color yarn of your choice.*

**Round 1:** Sc 5 in the magic circle

**Round 2:** Sc 2 in each sc around (10 sts)

**Round 3:** \*Sc 1, 2 sc in next sc\* rep 5 times (15 sts)

**Round 4-6:** Sc 15.

*Change to a contrasting color.*

**Round 7:** Sc 15.

*Change back to the main color.*

**Round 8:** Sc 15.

Fasten off and weave in end.

Cut a piece of white yarn (2"). Wrap white yarn 10 times around the small piece of cardboard. Carefully slide it off and tie the 2" piece onto the middle of your yarn. Make sure it's tight!

Now, cut through the loops of your "8" like figure. When you have done that, you created a very tiny pompom for on the winter hat! :)

If you like, you can use a comb to comb the pompom (hold tightly at the knot!), so it is more fluffy!

Now cut of any weird excess pieces of the pompom, but leave the yarn where you tied it with. You can use that to tie it to the winter hat. Just insert the pieces on top of the winter hat with your tapestry needle, then tie on the inside.

## Card

### Snowman

- First of all, print out the template page of the pattern.
- Cut out the template pieces (head and body).
- Trace the pieces with the pencil on the white paper.
- Cut out your traced pieces.
- Cut out a small circle (like on the template) out of the red paper. You could use a perforator for it.
- Glue the circle on the face part as the nose. Draw small eyes and a cute mouth with the black fineliner.
- Glue on two small buttons on the body piece of the snowman. If you don't have any, use the colored scraps where you cut out circles (or use a perforator).
- Glue the head onto the body, just barely overlapping them, but securely glued together.
- Take two pieces of yarn. I mostly use the color of the striped part of the winter hat for it. Wrap them around the "neck" of the snowman. Tie a knot on the rightside, pull the ends to the lower part of the body, glue them to the body and cut of excess pieces of yarn.
- Put on some 3D-foampads on the back. Be sure to not put them higher then the neck; the winter hat must fit on the head. When it's on the card. :)

### Card

- Fold your cardstock in half so you have a card. Stick on the snowman and put on the head. You can glue it on, but I just left mine so people who recieved the card can take it off. :)
